Title: Principal

General Description: The Northeast Regional High School of Biotechnology and Agriscience (NERSBA) is located in northeastern North Carolina and serves students in Washington, Tyrrell, Beaufort, Martin, and Pitt counties. This school is located on the campus of the Vernon G. James Research and Extension Center just five miles east of Plymouth. NERSBA is a state-of-the-art STEM Early College high school designed to promote personal, local, and global well-being where students can earn college credit while completing a rigorous high school curriculum. The principal position is available for a dynamic individual, who leads by example, has experience in agriscience and biotechnology, has a working knowledge in the STEM Early College high school initiative, understands the diverse culture in a rural farming area, is an innovative solution seeker, and encourages the participation of business and entrepreneur leadership.

Responsibilities: The successful candidate will develop a school culture that embraces its biotechnology and agriscience theme. He/She will be responsible for recruiting and recommending to the Board for employment a highly qualified team that will be proactive in promoting a college going culture through high expectations and academic rigor. He/She will foster the collaboration of faculty and staff between NERSBA, NCSU, and any business partners to enhance the educational experiences and promote sustainability.

Qualifications: The successful candidate must have a minimum of a Master Degree in Agricultural education or related degree and a minimum of three years of teaching in a middle school and/or high school setting. He/She must hold a principal certificate or be eligible for NC license as a K12 principal or on tract to do so. He/She must also bring an expertise in school and/or business administration including but not limited to budgeting, staff and team building and in-servicing, recruitment of staff and students, fund raising skills, scheduling, curriculum development and student discipline. This person should be a visionary with the skill to creatively develop and implement new approaches to the total education and achievement of students.

Salary and Benefits: Contributory participation in the North Carolina Teachers and State Employees Retirements System, with health coverage, vacation, and sick leave provided. Salary is negotiable with education and professional experience.
